of the first part, in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) to it paid by the CONSUMERS POWER COMPANY, a Maine corporation authorized to do business in Michigan, of the second part, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Convey and Warrant to the party of the second part, its successors and assigns, Forever, the easement and right to erect and maintain electric lines, consisting of ~~wires~~ poles, wires and distributing appliances for the purpose of transmitting and distributing electricity, on, over, and across the following described parcel... of land in the

City... of... Grand Rapids... County of... Kent... and State of Michigan, to-wit: Lots Numbered one (1) and two (2) of Canton Smith's Addition to the City of Grand Rapids, according to the recorded plat thereon.

The route to be taken by said line of ~~wires~~ poles and wires across said land being more specifically described as follows:

No poles to be set on said land; only line of wires to overhead in a Northerly and Southerly direction East of and along and adjoining the West line of said above described land on a line as located and staked.

With full right and authority to the party of the second part, its successors or assigns, and its and their agents, servants and employees, to enter at all times upon said premises for the purpose of constructing, repairing, removing, replacing and maintaining such ~~wires~~ poles and other supports, with all necessary braces, guys, anchors and transformers, and stringing thereon and supporting and suspending therefrom lines of wire or other conductors, for the transmission of electrical energy, and to trim or remove any ~~tree~~ which at any time may interfere or threaten to interfere with the maintenance of such lines.
